PROFILE AND HEADER PHOTOS

FACEBOOK

Profile picture

1. Sign in to www.facebook.com or open the Facebook app.
2. From your feed, click on pages in the left menu.
3. Go to your page.
4. Click in the bottom right of your page's profile picture and select edit profile picture.
5. Select one available photo or upload one from your computer (clicking on upload photo).
6. Click save.

Header photo

1. Sign in to www.facebook.com or open the Facebook app.
2. From your feed, click on pages in the left menu.
3. Go to your page.
4. Click in the bottom right of your page's header picture and select choose from photos or upload photo.
5. Select your new header photo.
6. Click save.

INSTAGRAM

Profile picture

1. Sign in to www.instagram.com or open your Instagram app.
2. Click your profile picture on the left to go to your profile.
3. Click edit profile.
4. Click change profile photo.
5. Click upload photo, and then select your picture to import.
6. You can take a new photo or add a photo from your phone's photo library or Facebook. If you choose to import from Facebook, Instagram will use the same picture you're already using for your Facebook profile.

TWITTER

Profile picture and header photo

1. Sign in to www.twitter.com or open your Twitter app.

2. Go to your profile on the left side.
3. Click the edit profile button and you'll be able to edit your header photo, also known as a "banner" and your profile photo.
4. When changing a profile or header photo, click or tap the camera icon and select upload photo or remove.
5. Click save.

YOUTUBE

Profile picture and header photo

1. Sign in to www.youtube.com and go to your channel page (clicking on your profile photo on the left top corner).
2. From the left menu, select customize channel and then branding.
3. Click change and select an image (under picture for the profile picture and under banner image for the header photo). Change the size of your image to adjust it, then click done.
4. Click publish (it may take a few minutes for your profile picture or header photo to update across Youtube).
